Need

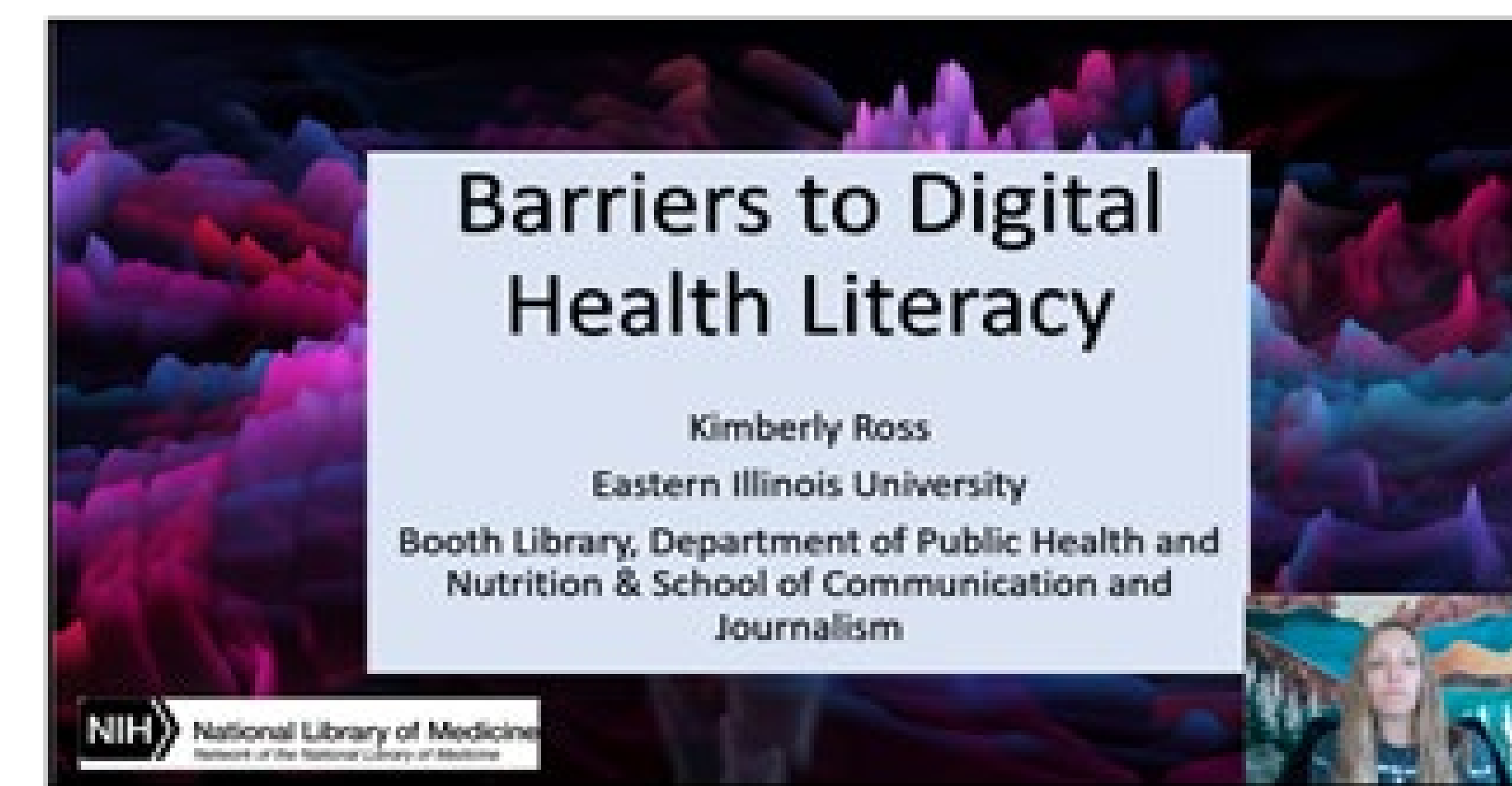
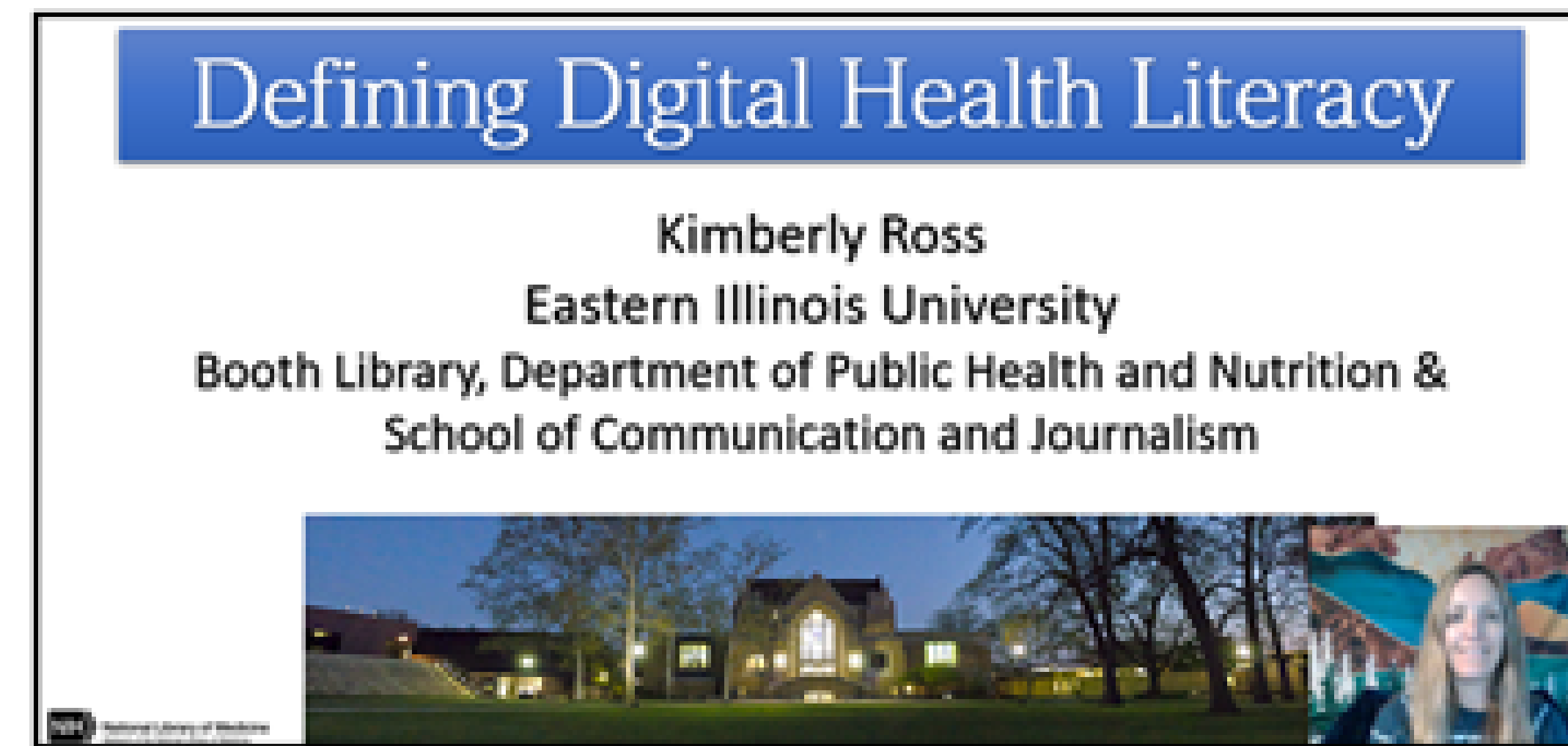
- Rural health literacy
